



1 GENERAL

- a) SPORT SELECT - FUTURES is NOT associated with or authorized by any professional or amateur sports league or association, member teams, players or other affiliates in any way.
- b) SPORT SELECT - FUTURES is governed by the Rules and Regulations Respecting Lotteries and Gaming of WESTERN CANADA LOTTERY CORPORATION (WCLC) WHICH INCLUDE LIMITATIONS OF LIABILITY AND ARE AVAILABLE FROM WCLC UPON REQUEST and these Game Conditions and Prize Structure Statement.
- c) WCLC may amend these Game Conditions and Prize Structure Statement at any time and in any manner.
- d) In these Game Conditions:

“Active SPORT SELECT FUTURES Event List” is the SPORT SELECT FUTURES Event List entered in WCLC's computer containing those Events available for wagering at the time of purchase. Only one such list is an Active SPORT SELECT FUTURES Event List at any given time.

“All-In, Play or Not” means the final results on Predictions for an Event as determined by WCLC will stand regardless of Non-Starters and regardless of whether or not all possible predictions for an Event were offered for wagers.

“Event” means a competition or match-up between two (2) or more teams or individuals, participating in (one, or a series of) sporting events (or other types of competitions) and which is an individually numbered competition offered by WCLC for wagering on an Active SPORT SELECT FUTURES Event List.

“Non-Starter” means a team, individual or other participant listed as a Prediction for an Event withdraws, is disqualified, penalized, eliminated or otherwise fails to participate in an Event;

“Obvious Errors” include, but are not limited to, wagers offered or placed at odds that are materially different from those available in the general North American betting market for a given Event at the time the wager was placed or wagers offered or placed at odds being clearly incorrect given the probability of the event occurring (or not occurring) at the time the wager was placed.

“Predictions” means specific betting predictions for an Event which are available for wagering.

2 ISSUANCE OF TICKETS

- a) To obtain a ticket, a person must present a completed SPORT SELECT - FUTURES selection slip or QR code with 1 Event and 1 Prediction selected from the Active SPORT SELECT - FUTURES Event List available at Lotto Spot Retailers and sportselect.com and pay the authorized retailer the chosen wager of \$2 to \$100 before the wagering cut-off time of the Event chosen from the Active SPORT SELECT – FUTURES Event List, whereupon a ticket will be issued showing the purchase date, particulars of the selection, associated odds, potential payout, amount wagered, control number(s) and other relevant information.
- b) A QR code generated for wagering purposes is not a ticket.
- c) WCLC, in its sole discretion, can change the odds for any Event Prediction at any time. The odds printed on the player’s ticket at time of purchase will be official for that wager except where cancellations, past postings or other odds assignments pursuant to these Game Conditions apply.
- d) WCLC may, in its sole discretion, suspend sales (temporarily or permanently) on any Event.
- e) In the event of any discrepancy, conflict or inconsistency between published Event information and odds, and the official Event information and odds available from WCLC, the latter shall prevail.
- f) WCLC may, in its sole discretion, void any wager(s) accepted in Obvious Error and in such case an odds value of 1.00 shall be assigned to the selected Prediction of the affected Event(s) on the affected ticket(s).
- g) WCLC, in its sole discretion, will cancel an Event entered in error, and in such case an odds value of 1.00 shall be assigned to each of the Predictions of the Event.

3 RESULTS

- a) Results are the final results of the Events indicated on the Active SPORT SELECT – FUTURES Event List as determined by WCLC.
- b) Results are final when declared by WCLC and are not affected by any subsequent amendments, corrections, disqualifications or other events.

- c) In the event that WCLC is not able to determine the final results of an Event, such Event shall be considered cancelled and an odds value of 1.00 shall be assigned to each of the Predictions of that Event.
- d) For greater certainty if the name of a player or team has been spelled incorrectly, wagers placed will stand.
- e) If a ticket contains a selection of a Prediction of an Event that has actually commenced or been completed, or for which the result was otherwise already known, prior to the issuance of such ticket, such selection shall be 'Past Posted' and have an odds value of 1.00 assigned to that selection on that ticket.
- f) Futures Event wagers are offered on an All-In, Play or Not basis, unless otherwise stated.
- g) In cases where an Event is cancelled an odds value of 1.00 shall be assigned to each of the Predictions of that Event.
- h) Unless stated otherwise, final results take into account any official tie breaks.
- i) In the event of any discrepancy, conflict or inconsistency between published Event final results, and the official Event final results recorded in WCLC's computer, the latter shall prevail.
- j) In the case of a tie in a SPORT SELECT – FUTURES Event where two (2) or more Predictions in the same Event are determined the winning Predictions, the Event will be cancelled and an odds value of 1.00 shall be assigned to each of the Predictions of that Event. The foregoing does not apply to a SPORT SELECT – FUTURES Event in which there is a "tie" or "draw" option prediction available for wagering.

4 WINNING TICKETS

- a) Any valid ticket bearing a Winning Prediction is a winning ticket and entitles its holder(s) to claim a prize calculated by multiplying the amount wagered by the odds of the Winning Prediction as shown on the Active SPORT SELECT FUTURES Event List from which the selection of the Prediction was made, or, where applicable, by the odds assigned to such Prediction pursuant to these Game Conditions.
- b) A Winning Prediction is one that bears the exact result for the Event selected in accordance with the Active SPORT SELECT – FUTURES Event List for the Event.

5 PRIZE CLAIMS

- a) Prizes must be claimed in the manner stated on the back of the ticket within one (1) year following the date of the declaration by WCLC of the final result of the Event selected on the ticket.

6 LIMITATIONS

- a) In all cases, the prize that shall be available to be won on any one SPORT SELECT - FUTURES ticket shall be limited to Ninety Nine Thousand Nine Hundred (\$99,900.00) Dollars, as such amount may be modified by subparagraph (b) hereof.
- b) The aggregate amount of prizes that may be won on any day on SPORT SELECT – FUTURES tickets shall be limited to a maximum of One Million (\$1,000,000.00) Dollars. If, at the end of a particular day, the aggregate amount of prizes that could be won, but for this provision, would exceed One Million (\$1,000,000.00) Dollars, then the aggregate amount of prizes payable on all winning tickets purchased for SPORT SELECT - FUTURES for that day shall automatically be reduced, and the amount payable as a prize in respect of each such winning ticket for that day shall be equal to:
- (i) the amount wagered by such ticket, plus
- (ii) the amount that would have been payable as a prize before any reduction less the amount of the wager multiplied by a fraction, having as its numerator One Million (\$1,000,000.00) Dollars, less the aggregate of all amounts wagered on SPORT SELECT - FUTURES for that day and, as its denominator, the aggregate amount of prizes that would have been payable on all winning SPORT SELECT - FUTURES tickets purchased for that day before any reduction, less the aggregate of all amounts wagered, i.e.:

7 CANCELLATION OF A TICKET

- a) A player may only cancel a SPORT SELECT - FUTURES ticket at the authorized retailer where such ticket was issued and provided that such ticket is cancelled on the same business day the ticket was issued and prior to the start time of the Event chosen. Cancelled tickets are void.

8 ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS

- a) Unless otherwise stated, if a participant (such as a team, player or other option) in an Event, not listed as a potential Prediction wins a SPORT SELECT - FUTURES Event in which there is no “field” or “other” option prediction available for wagering, all Predictions which were listed will be considered non-winners and the result for that Event will be reported as ‘None’.
- b) Except as provided in subparagraphs e) and f) below, wagers on season long offerings such as (but not limited to) league champions and player awards will stand regardless of whether the season is shortened, delayed, or involves any other schedule changes, so long as the governing body officially recognizes these accomplishments and awards. If they do not, then the Event will be cancelled and shall have an odds value of 1.00 assigned to each of the Predictions of that Event.
- c) Suspended events, whether a race, tournament or otherwise (that doesn’t fit the definition of a “season”) must resume play within one (1) week of the date of suspension for wagers to stand. If they do not, then the Event will be cancelled and shall have an odds value of 1.00 assigned to each of the Predictions of that Event.
- d) Postponed events, whether a race, tournament or otherwise (that doesn’t fit the definition of a “season”) must have a rescheduled date available by the original start date and must commence within one (1) calendar month of the original start date for the Event. If they do not, then the Event will be cancelled and shall have an odds value of 1.00 assigned to each of the Predictions of that Event.
- e) For regular season team wins/points Events, results are based on regular season games only and do not include any playoff, play in or other postseason games. Subject to the sport specific minimum play requirements outlined in (i) to (v) below, wagers on a regular season team win/point Event will stand regardless of whether the season is shortened, delayed, or involves any other schedule changes, so long as the governing body officially recognizes the season. If they do not recognize the season, then the Event will be cancelled and shall have an odds value of 1.00 assigned to each of the Predictions of that Event.
 - (i) Hockey NHL – Unless otherwise stated, a team must complete at least 82 regular season games for wagers to stand, provided the remaining games during the course of the season not played do not affect the result. If this is not the case, then the Event will be cancelled and shall have an odds value of 1.00 assigned to each of the Predictions of that Event.
 - (ii) Baseball MLB - Unless otherwise stated, a team must complete at least 160 regular season games for wagers to stand, provided the remaining games during the course of the season not played do not affect the result.

If this is not the case, then the Event will be cancelled and shall have an odds value of 1.00 assigned to each of the Predictions of that Event.

- (iii) Basketball NBA - Unless otherwise stated, a team must complete at least 80 regular season games for wagers to stand, provided the remaining games during the course of the season not played do not affect the result. If this is not the case, then the Event will be cancelled and shall have an odds value of 1.00 assigned to each of the Predictions of that Event.
 - (iv) Football NFL & CFL - Unless otherwise stated, a team must complete all regular season games as outlined at the start of the season for wagers to stand, provided the remaining games during the course of the season not played do not affect the result. If this is not the case, then the Event will be cancelled and shall have an odds value of 1.00 assigned to each of the Predictions of that Event.
 - (v) For the purposes of the calculations of the minimum play requirements outlined in (i) to (iv) above a forfeited game recognized by the game governing body will count as a completed game.
- f) For regular season individual player performance total Events, results are based on regular season games only and do not include any playoff, play in or other postseason games. Subject to the sport specific minimum play requirements outlined in (i) to (iv) below, wagers on a regular season individual player performance total Event will stand irrespective of player trades and regardless of whether the season is shortened, delayed, or involves any other schedule changes, so long as the governing body officially recognizes the season. If they do not recognize the season, then the Event will be cancelled and shall have an odds value of 1.00 assigned to each of the Predictions of that Event.
- (i) Hockey NHL – The player involved in the Event must play at least one second in at least one regular season game after the time the wager is made or the selection of the Prediction of that Event on that ticket will be cancelled and shall have an odds value of 1.00 assigned to that selection on that ticket.
 - (ii) Baseball MLB – The player involved in the Event must play in at least one regular season game after the time the wager is made or the selection of the Prediction of that Event on that ticket will be cancelled and shall have an odds value of 1.00 assigned to that selection on that ticket.
 - (iii) Basketball NBA – The player involved in the Event must play at least one second in at least one regular season game after the time the wager is made or the selection of the Prediction of that Event on that ticket will be cancelled and shall have an odds value of 1.00 assigned to that selection on that ticket.

- (iv) Football NFL & CFL – The player involved in the Event must take part in at least one play in at least one regular season game after the time the wager is made or the selection of the Prediction of that Event on that ticket will be cancelled and shall have an odds value of 1.00 assigned to that selection on that ticket.

The FUTURES Game Conditions and Prize Structure Statement described herein take effect on September 1, 2026.
